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



Police Personnel Cost Survey


- ➤ PERF conducted a budget survey of 297 various sized Police Departments throughout the U.S.
- ➤On average, it found that those police department's spent 85% of their annual budgets on personnel costs.
- ➤ The range of these percentages was from 61% to 98.5%.
- ➤The proposed Pine Grove Regional P.D.'s personnel costs are 78%, or 7% under the national survey average.







Total Population 12,453 with 21 Full-Time Officers

- DCED (IACP Formula) estimated the annual incidents to be 6,849
- In 2016, the actual reported incidents were 6,691 (- 158)
- For 2015, DCED estimated the Cost per Officer to be \$107,700
- For 2017, the actual Cost per Officer was \$114,285 (+ 6% over 3 years)
- From 2016 thru 2019, the total PD budget has increased only 3.35%
- From 2015 to 2017, the total grant amounts received was \$270,000

Polaris 900 ATV given to the Slate Belt Regional Police Department in October, 2018 with a grant from Monroe County. Cost is approximately \$15,000.

- In 2017, the grant amounts received were \$138,261
- In 2018, they began construction on a new \$4.5 M Police HQ
